We're accepting applications for a new class of docent educators for Frank Lloyd Wright's Zimmerman House – the only Wright house open to the public in New England. A background in architecture isn't necessary, but applicants should have a desire to learn about architecture and art and an enthusiasm to engage the public.

Those accepted will participate in a 10-week training course from March 22 to May 17 led by Currier staff and standing docents. Classes will be held on Wednesday afternoons as well as a couple of Saturday mornings. Topics include an exploration of Frank Lloyd Wright's buildings and major ideas; a consideration of the Zimmerman House from multiple perspectives; an introduction to the Currier's collections; and practical training on how to give meaningful tours. Homework, in-class writing assignments and discussions, and a graduation tour are requirements; we also ask that docents-in-training shadow at least two tours.

Upon completion of the program, new docents begin giving Zimmerman House tours. Fifty hours of service are required each year and training opportunities are ongoing.
