Join a new class of docent educators!

We're accepting applications for the Museum docent program at the Currier Museum of Art. A background in art isn't necessary, but applicants should have a desire to learn about works of art and an enthusiasm to engage the public.

Those accepted will participate in a required 7-week training course from September 12 to October 24 led by Currier staff and standing docents. Classes will be held on Tuesday afternoons as well as on a couple of Tuesday mornings. Topics include a historical overview of the Currier; exposure to major works in the collection; an introduction to the exhibition, "The Paris of Toulouse-Lautrec," opening in late September; and practical training on how to give meaningful tours. Homework, in-class writing assignments and discussions, and a graduation tour are requirements; we also ask that docents-in-training shadow at least two tours.

Upon completion of the program, new docents begin giving tours. Fifty hours of service are required each year and training opportunities are ongoing.
