

Class Level Tiers (Adult Classes)

Class level: Introductory - Students may have little or no experience in this medium or any artmaking method. Instructors set pace based on class progress and focus on introducing essential techniques and concepts.

Beginner – Students have some experience in this medium, or another similar artmaking method. Instructors set pace based on class progress to achieve course goals. Introductory concepts are reinforced while most of class time is focused towards developing techniques and skills while building confidence in this medium.

Intermediate/Studio Course – Students are confident with their experience in this medium, or another similar artmaking method. Instructors set class pace to achieve course goals. In a studio course, students may also determine their own individual pacing.

Advanced- Students are confident with good experience and seek to learn techniques and strategies that support their personal goals and increased mastery of this medium.
